Our Virtual Halloween Hike for Hospice is an online fundraising initiative that allows you to register and hold your own symbolic 'walk' and still fundraise for an important cause. How do I get an event T-shirt?

2020 Hike t-shirts are available to the first 400 hikers register. Tshirts will be available for a scheduled pick-up time at Foothills Country Hospice, or we can mail them to you if you live out of town.

Participants are invited to honour their loved one in any way that they wish (pictures, signs, costumes, shirt designs are welcomed). "Hiking in Honour of NAME" race bibs will also be available for those wishing to wear one.

How does my donation help?

Foothills Country Hospice is a not-for-profit organization challenged with fundraising \$1.3M annually. We count on donors and supporters like you to raise more than \$50,000 each year during Hike for Hospice. 100% of the funds raised at the Hike will go towards providing expert care and bereavement services at Foothills Country Hospice.

Will I receive a charitable tax receipt for my donation?

Foothills Country Hospice is a registered charity and all donations \$20 and greater will receive a charitable tax receipt. Online donations receive an immediate receipt via e-mail. Please be sure to keep it handy for your records. Those who make offline donations (cash or cheque) will get a tax receipt mailed (or emailed) to them after the event. Please note, registration fees are not tax deductible.
