Turn right and continue South on Hwy. #22.

Pass by Burby Bridge and continue South.

Quiz question: what local large animal is honored by the statue on your left?

Ans.: Antler Ridge Estates

You are currently travelling in an area referred to by the named mountain it contains.

Quiz question: what is the name of that Mountain?

Ans.: Moose Mtn.

If there's "Barns to the left of me Joker's on the Right, here I am stuck in the middle with you."

As you continue South on **Hwy. #762** you should see Square Butte Hall o your Left. You will soon approach the intersection of Hwy. #762 & Hwy. #549. Turn left (East).

Continue South past Hillside Acres Horse boarding. (on your left)

Follow this road South to the infamous Oilfield town who's Initials are T.V.

Quiz question: When was Turner Valley incorporated?

Ans.: 1930

Quiz question: What is the name of the discovery Well that sparked Alberta's First Oil Boom in 1914?

Ans.: Dingman No. #1

Quiz question: What is the name of the Well that sparked Alberta's second Oil Boom and in what year did it begin?

Ans.: Royalite No. #4 in 1924

Bonus question: What is this wells' *nickname*?

Ans.: "Wonder Well"

Continue into Turner Valley to the 4 Way stop on their main drag. Turn left and continue East.

Quiz question: What is painted on the back wall of the trailer on the Moto-Burrito lot?

Ans.: Mexican Skulls

Continue heading East to the town of Black Diamond. At the first major intersection turn Right and head **South on Hwy. #22.**

As you continue South out of Black Diamond you will see a nameless Farm on your Right.

Quiz question: How many windows are in the large barn door on this farm?

Ans.: 3

Continue South past Tongue Creek Road (a.k.a. Hwy. #543) You will note several pump-jacks on either side of the highway.

Quiz question: What is the Oil Field nickname for a pump-jack?

Ans.: Nodding Donkey

As you climb the large hill in front of you, you should see a small historic site monument on your Right.

Quiz question: What is the name of the Small Town honored at this monument and what are perched on the four corners of the fence surrounding the monument?

Return to **Hwy. #22** and continue South into Longview.

You will find your (4th) Check Stop at the Twin Cities Hotel.

As you travel further **South** on **Hwy. #22** be certain to take-in the views of lush hillsides and winding coulee creeks.

Quiz question: how many Silos are in the field of Ball Caps?

Ans.: 3

Bonus question: what other varieties of head cover can be found on the ball cap fencing?

Ans: Hard Hat, Helmut, Wide Brimmed Hat

Find your location on the West facing Map in this display kiosk. You arrived at this location by travelling here on the Red road depicted on the map. Your departure Route (for Leg 6) is depicted by a black road that begins at the Entrance/Exit to Chain Lakes Provincial Park.

As you embark on this final leg of the Rally, you should be watching for the first Ranch (Grey roof & Cream colored tank) you see on your left. Stop across from the entrance to this property.

Quiz question: What activity is depicted by the metal plate affixed to the top of this properties entrance gate?

Ans.: Calf Roping

Continue East on the this road.

Quiz question: How far is the Willow Springs Arena from the road you are travelling on?

Ans.: 2 kilometers

Continue East enjoying the Foothills vista's to your North & South.

Quiz question: What Municipal District are you now travelling in?

Ans.: Willow Creek #26

Bonus question: What is the name of the creek that runs through this area?

Ans.: Diamond Willow Creek

Quiz question: As you continue East along this Hwy. what color is the first grain auger you see?

Ans.: White & Blue

Quiz question: What are "The Foxes" sitting on?

Ans.: A large Rock

Quiz question: What color is the roof of the building at the Sunburst Ranch?

Ans.: Blue

As you continue East along this Hwy. pay attention to what's on your right.

You'll soon find yourself travelling North. Prepare to turn Right at the 3 way intersection.

Quiz question: What shape is the stack of Hay Bales at Bear Trap Feeders?

Ans.: Rectangular

Continue East on Hwy. #533.

Quiz question: What color grain auger will you find just before Top Hat Live-Stock sign?

Ans.: Yellow

As you approach the Town of Nanton take note of the Old Macleod Trail Monument to your left. Prepare to stop (safely) to find the answer to the next question.

Quiz Question: What other name was the Old Macleod Trail known as?

Ans.: The Great North Trail

As you arrive at Hwy. #2, cross the South bound lanes and turn Left onto **Hwy. #2 North** and proceed through Nanton.

Quiz question: What purpose does the Orange & Yellow Grain Elevator now serve?

Ans.: Canadian Grain Elevator Discovery Centre

Continue through town and prepare to head East on Hwy. #533. Continue past the Nanton Agri-Park (on your Left) Prepare to turn left just past the "Amazing Tee Box" onto Range Rd. #282.

Continue North on Hwy. #2.

Quiz question: What Flag flies as you pass the White fence line?

Ans.: Canadian

Prepare to leave Hwy. #2 at Exit #197. Turn Left at the lights and head West ... for the last time!

Quiz question: Who has a real passion for White Silos?

Ans.: Interstar

As you head West on Hwy #543 take note of the multi-windowed building on your left.

Bonus question: what service was this building once used for?

Ans.: Military Air Base

Continue West on Hwy. #543. After crossing over Hwy. #2A you will arrive at your final destination on your Left The Sunset Drive-In.
